Steps to Replicate: Note: This issue does not replicate from scratch. Steps serve as a guide.

- 1. Log into Blackboard Learn Ultra Experience as an administrator
- 2. Copy a course into a new one using the Admin Panel course copy. Copy the entire folder. This is for not modifying the affected course.
- 3. In the new course, if the overall grade column is not present, create one
- 4. Using the copy content menu, copy the course into this new test course
- 5. Once the copy finishes, look for the overall grade column in the target course
