Description: Browser autofill inserts Username and password in fields that may result in undesired changes.

Steps to Replicate:

1. Start Chrome.

- 2. Change settings to Offer to Save Passwords.
- 3. Remove Blackboard page from lists in the Passwords settings module of Chrome.
- 4. Save and close settings.
- 5. Go to main Blackboard Login Page and log in.
- 6. If Chrome asks to save password, save it and log out, if not, log out. (Username and asterisk password should now be displayed in their fields)
- 7. Log in using those credentials.
- 8. Go To System Admin tab > Data Integration module > Student Information System Integrations page.
- 9. Context menu for an IMS LIS type integration > click Edit.

Observed Behavior:

The password will now be in field "Shared Password" and your username will be in Batch Uid Prefix auto-filled in.

Note: You can even see your password if you click "Show Shared Password" under Shared Password.

Resolution/Workaround: Learn cannot override Browser features/behavior.
