Subheader Text Color Rollover Color and Add Menu Item Text Color Issues with Bb Learn 2016 Theme

Description: There are 3 issues with the Bb Learn 2016 theme on Q2 2018 when using Customization > Teaching Style > Background Color and Text Color. Subheader text color does not change to match the Text Color selected. Subheader text has the same rollover (when the mouse is over the text) color as all over course menu items. Add Menu Item text color does not change to match the Text Color selected.

Steps to Replicate:

1. Confirm the Default Brand is the only brand and it has the Bb Learn 2016 theme assigned in System Admin > Brands and Themes > Manage Brands.
2. Create a Course.
3. Open the newly created Course.
4. Create a subheader using Add Menu Item (plus button top left of the course menu). Note all Course menu text is white and the subheader is bold white.
5. Navigate to Customization > Teaching Style.
6. In Select Menu Style, select Style = Text.
7. In Select Menu Style, change Text Color and Background Color to different non white colors using the color palette, clicking Apply after each.
8. Click Submit.

Observed Behavior:

Subheader text color does not change to match the Text Color selected.

Subheader text has the same rollover (when the mouse is over the text) color as all over course menu items.

Add Menu Item text color does not change to match the Text Color selected.

Expected Behavior:

Subheader text color matches the Text Color selected.

Subheader text has no rollover (when the mouse is over the text) color.

Add Menu Item text color matches the Text Color selected.
