## Blackboard is pleased to announce the availability of the Blackboard Learn 9.1, 3900.2 Release (Build: 3900.2.0-rel.27+70f5845).

As a reminder, starting with the Learn 9.1 3900.0 release, the name has shifted from using the quarter/year as the name to a version number to align with the SaaS release model. There is also a new monthly release cadence for Learn 9.1 that includes bug fixes and feature improvements. You can choose any monthly 9.1 release and take improvements and bug fixes at any time. You do not have to wait until the next big twice-yearly release (Q2/Q4) to get an improvement you've been waiting for. The installer is run at the command line, using Gradle, Maven, and an installer properties file. This also requires your system to be down for the upgrade/install.
