Steps to Replicate:

- 2. Create a student user
- 3. Create a course and enroll the student in it
- 4. Create a content
- 5. Disable the student using SIS
- 6. Go to the Content page and enable the statistics tracking on
- 7. Select the View Statistics Report Run Content Usage Statistics

Observed Behavior:

The course disabled user (student) appears in the reports. Instructors need to remove this user manually from the list and continue to see the report.

Expected Behavior:

The course disabled user (student) should not appear in the reports.
